Isolation, Quarantine, and Close Contact Protocol

(Per CDC Health Update of 12/27/2021)

If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay home for 5 days. If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can return to school. Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days (DAY 6-10). If you choose not to be masked, then you will be required to quarantine for 10 days.

- With this updated revision, early return to school with a negative test is not applicable.
- If your child develops symptoms during this quarantine, please contact your physician for further guidance.
- If your child tests positive for COVID-19 after exposure, their quarantine period is 5 days from date of their positive result, if no symptoms present, or onset of symptoms

If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine)

If you:

Have been boosted OR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Wear a mask around others for 10 days. Test on day 5, if possible. If you choose not to be masked, then you will be required to quarantine for 10 days.
Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine within the last 6 months OR	
Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the last 2 months	

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.

If you:

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted OR	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days. Test on day 5, if possible. If you choose not to be masked, then you will be required to quarantine for 10 days.
Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago and are not boosted OR	
Are unvaccinated	

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home

If you:

Tested positive in the last 90 days	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Monitor for symptoms

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home

Household Cases: If the confirmed positive person is a household member, students must quarantine for 5 days after the initial 5-day isolation period of the confirmed positive household member. This is a total of 10 days for the quarantine. If your child reports no symptoms during daily monitoring of the above-mentioned quarantine period, they may return to school on the 11th day, **but must wear a mask from Day 11 through Day 15**. If you choose for your child to not wear a mask, then a 15-day quarantine will be required.
