Isolation, Quarantine, and Close Contact Protocol (Per CDC Health Update of 12/27/2021)

## If You Test Positive for COVID-19 (Isolate)

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status.	<ul> <li>Stay home for 5 days.</li> <li>If you have no symptoms or your symptoms are resolving after 5 days, you can return to school.</li> <li>Continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days (DAY 6-10).</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>If you choose not to be masked, then you will be required to quarantine for 10 days.</li> </ul>

- With this updated revision, early return to school with a negative test is not applicable.
- If your child develops symptoms during this quarantine, please contact your physician for further guidance.
- If your child tests positive for COVID-19 after exposure, their quarantine period is 5 days from date of their positive result, if no symptoms present, or onset of symptoms

# If You Were Exposed to Someone with COVID-19 (Quarantine)

### If you:

Have been boosted <b>OR</b>	<ul> <li>Wear a mask around others for 10 days.</li> </ul>
Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna	<ul> <li>Test on day 5, if possible.</li> </ul>
vaccine within the last 6 months <b>OR</b>	If you choose not to be masked, then you will be
Completed the primary series of J&J vaccine within the	required to quarantine for 10 days.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home.

## If you:

Completed the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna	<ul> <li>Stay home for 5 days. After that continue to wear</li> </ul>
vaccine over 6 months ago and are not boosted <b>OR</b>	a mask around others for 5 additional days.
Completed the primary series of J&J over 2 months ago	<ul> <li>Test on day 5, if possible.</li> </ul>
and are not boosted <b>OR</b>	If you choose not to be masked, then you will be
Are unvaccinated	required to quarantine for 10 days.

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home

#### If you:

Tested positive in the last 90 days	Monitor for symptoms

If you develop symptoms get a test and stay home

<u>Household Cases</u>: If the confirmed positive person is a household member, students must quarantine for 5 days after the initial 5-day isolation period of the confirmed positive household member. This is a total of 10 days for the quarantine. If your child reports no symptoms during daily monitoring of the above-mentioned quarantine period, they may return to school on the 11<sup>th</sup> day, but must wear a mask from Day 11 through Day 15. If you choose for your child to not wear a mask, then a 15-day quarantine will be required.
