The goal of the Bellwood-Antis School District (BASD) is to keep healthy students in school while maintaining protocols that provide a safe environment for others. Therefore, the BASD Administration has reviewed the CDC recommendations as they relate to the quarantining of individuals in the school setting. As a result, the BASD Health and Safety Plan is amended with the following updates:

COVID Positive – If a person tests positive for COVID-19, regardless of vaccination status, he/she is to isolate (stay home) for 5 days following symptom onset or positive test result. If no longer showing symptoms or symptoms are resolving, he/she may return to school while continuing to wear a mask for 5 additional days (day 6 through day 10). To return to school, students and employees must have a doctor's note as per school district attendance policy.

Close Contact – Exposure to someone with COVID-19 – an individual determined to be a close contact (within 6 feet for 15 consecutive minutes), regardless of vaccination status, will be expected to mask for <u>five days</u> following exposure and continue to closely monitor for symptoms for an additional five days.

Summary of other updates to and reminders about the Health and Safety Plan:

- Students are no longer required to wear masks/face coverings on school buses or other school district transportation.
- BASD will **no** longer require **temperature checks** at school by staff
- BASD will continue to recognize a positive home test. If you receive a positive result with a home test, we recommend you verify this with your doctor.
- Communicate with the school nurse about illness, symptoms, and testing.
- DO NOT to send your child to school if he/she is exhibiting symptoms.

Any issues not clarified on this recommendation will be managed according to most recent CDC recommendations.
